Information for Club Members

The Saticoy Senior Men's Golf Club plays golf every Thursday morning (with the exception of some holidays) at 7:00am. Upon arriving at the golf course you should do three things right away, (1) check in with the tournament chairman so you will be assigned to a foursome when the names are called, (2) go to the pro shop and pay your green fees, (3) get your equipment ready to play golf. All this should be accomplished before by 6:45 am.

It is your responsibility to make sure all of your numbers / information is entered accurately and legibly on your scorecard each time you play. Our Tournament Chairman will collect all scorecards at the end of play each Thursday. The Handicap Chairman will enter all scores weekly from your scorecards "As-Is" including proper adjustments where required on the computer in the Pro Shop for transmission to our handicap service. Please note this is done only for our Thursday Games.

If you are playing an away game, (not our home course), it will be your responsibility to enter your score on the computer at the course you just played. These games are entered as away games and cannot be posted on any other computer. If you play a game at our local course other than on Thursday, you should post your score on the computer in the Pro Shop. If you need help in posting do not hesitate to contact one of the officers or someone in the Pro Shop who will be glad to assist you.

Our club usually issues a newsletter called the "Pars 'N Scars" in which we try to record club events, both past and future, and other matters of interest. Also a club web site is maintained with lots of information, club events etc. A Club Roster is maintained and available on request. Please let us know when any of your information; address, telephone, e-mail address, etc. changes so we can keep this document up to date.

A couple of items worth reviewing in our golf application we all signed and agreed to when we became a member of the Saticoy Senior Men's Golf Club are:

Applicant agrees to: (1) practice good golf etiquette, (2) treat all other members respectfully, (3) provide assistance to club operations when requested, (4) follow the rules of golf, includes the club local rules, and the provisions of the constitution and by-laws. A copy of the local rules and club by-laws will be provided on request.

It is our wish that you take an active part in the weekly tournaments and in doing so will become acquainted with the entire membership. Enjoy and have fun.
